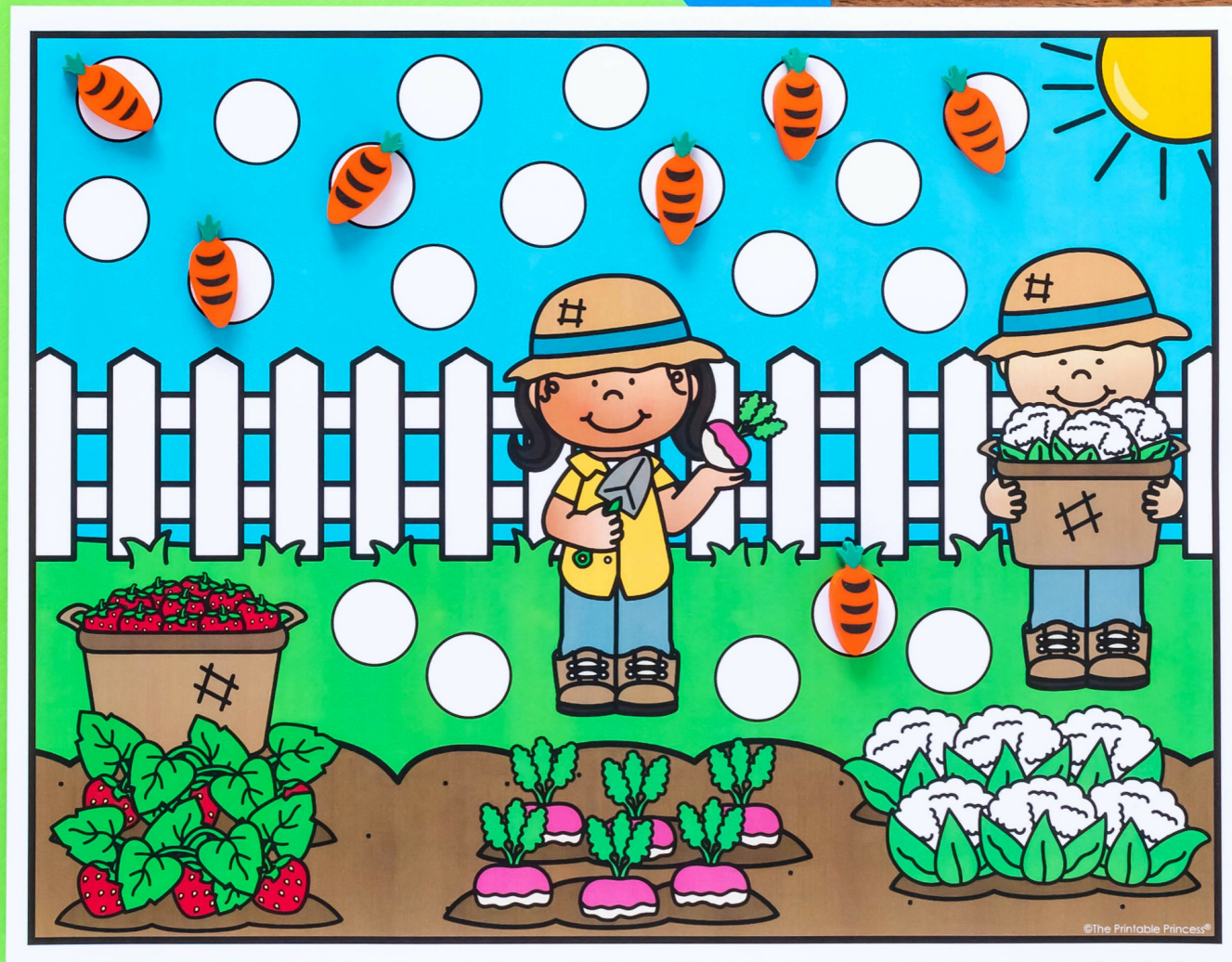


# GAME MATS

25 MATS FOR ANY ACTIVITY



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# Directions for Activities:

This resource includes 25 game boards. There are a variety of seasonal as well as everyday themes included, to keep this game fun and fresh. These boards make practicing any skill more fun.

You can use these to practice a variety of math and literacy skills. Simply ask students review questions and if they get the answer correct, they get to cover a spot on their game board. The first player to cover all the spaces wins. You can also use these for a partner game, by using the directions below.

**How to prepare:** To prepare this activity simply print and laminate the mats you wish to use or slide in a page protector. Each player will need their own mat and 20 game pieces to cover their board. You can use mini erasers, plastic cubes, or other small manipulatives. – If you want students to have less spaces for a shorter game, they can cover 5 or 10 spaces as “free” spaces.

**Ideas for use:** Have students read or spell sight words, answer addition and subtraction sentences, spell or read CVC or CVCe words, etc. You can use the letter and number cards included to start with an alphabet or number game.

**Partner Game Idea:** Before the game begins, players will place each of their 20 game pieces on their game mat, one per white circle. To decide which player begins the game, players will take turns rolling the dot cube once. The player who rolls the larger number goes first.

Players will take turns rolling the dot cube and counting to determine the number they rolled. They will remove that many game pieces from their game board. Players will continue to take turns rolling and removing until a player removes all of their game pieces. To remove all of the game pieces, the player must roll the exact number needed. For example, if a player has two left on their game board, they must roll a two to win the game.



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
